Uniform: Please can you make sure that your child is in the correct school uniform. We understand that there was a period of time during lockdown where allowances needed to be made, however with all retail shops opening, clothing and shoes are now more accessible. It is now expected that all children come to school appropriately dressed as per the list below:

- Grey pinafore or skirt
- Grey trousers or shorts
- Summer dress in pale blue/white check
- Navy embroidered sweatshirt / cardigan
- Short sleeved pale blue polo shirt
- Plain grey or white socks
- Plain grey or navy tights
- Black school shoes (not trainers)

Drop off and collection: Please strictly adhere to your child's arranged time for drop off and pick up. When collecting your children please ensure you leave the school grounds immediately.

Absences: If your child is absent you must inform the School Office by 9.15am where possible. Please use the report an absence function on the website, email admin@mosshey.stockport.sch.uk or telephone 439 5114 after 8.30am. Please ensure you give a brief description of the symptoms your child is experiencing.

Covid Symptoms: If your child is displaying one of the symptoms of Covid, they and any siblings must remain at home until a negative Covid test result has been received. Please report any Covid test results before returning to school to the School office or Head teacher if it comes back at a weekend to headteacher@mosshey.stockport.sch.uk

Please see the details below of how to obtain lateral flow tests should you wish to test regularly at home.

Please note that if your child is experiencing any symptoms of Covid, you will still need to book a PCR test at a testing centre for your child before they can return to school, a lateral flow test cannot be used instead.

Lateral Flow Devices: Lateral Flow Devices are now available for any member of the public to use at home. The scheme is called Community Collect.

Community collect: get a test at home

All adults can now get a box of 7 lateral flow tests to take twice a week at home.

You will need to give some personal details such as name and postcode when you collect the kit.

You do not need to book.

You can collect your kits in about 5 to 10 minutes.

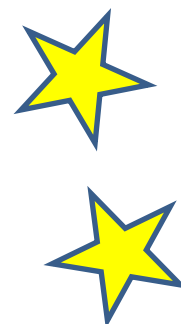
