Nasal flu vaccine consent: If you have not already done so, please complete the online nasal flu vaccine consent form sent via Parentmail. Even if you do not want your child to have the vaccine, there is a NO form that you need to complete.

PTA: All are welcome to attend the PTA AGM taking place on Monday 23rd September from 7.30am in the school hall. The more the merrier.

Zumba: A Zumba class takes place in school every Tuesday evening 8.30pm-9.30pm and is run by a Mum from school. Classes are pay as you go costing £4.50 each. The first three classes for newcomers are half price and no booking is required, just turn up. It's a small, friendly group and classes are carried out in the dark with a few disco lights.

Arrival at school: The doors are open from 8.50am. All children need to be in school by 8.55am and the register is taken promptly at 9am.

Lunches: School dinners must be pre-ordered at home. This can be done using the School Grid website (previously Live Kitchen) and can be ordered for a whole term in advance. If you have lost your log in details, please contact the office and they can send a new password link. Ordering at home will save losing valuable teaching time each morning. We really appreciate your co-operation with this matter.

If your child has a packed lunch, please can you ask them to not throw uneaten food/rubbish away at school so that parents are able to see what has been eaten and what has not.

Communication: As well as our Moss Hey Messenger, families will receive letters / notices through Parentmail. Teachers are continuing to use Class Dojo to communicate with parents/carers in their class.

Absence reporting: You must contact the school office in the first instance to report your child's absence from school. Please telephone on 0161 439 5114 or email admin@mosshey.stockport.sch.uk stating your child's name, class and the reason for the

absence. Absence should be reported every day unless you are able to give a return date due to a planned procedure etc... If your child experiences sickness or diarrhoea then they must remain off school until 48 hours after the last episode.

Drop Off: Some families are still stopping their car in the middle of the road to let their children out. This is unsafe and you could be breaking the law by obstructing the road. Please find a safe place to park and then let the children out. Also please do not pull up in front of the school gates to let children out.

After school collections: Please ensure your child's class teacher is aware of any alternative collection arrangements for your child. If your child is going home with another parent or a family member who does not usually pick your child up from school either, send a Dojo message, speak to the class teacher in the morning or make sure the office have been informed. We cannot let your child go home with somebody without having received permission from parents.

Out of School: Please make sure bookings for Out of School are made in advance using School Gateway. Bookings can be made online up until 11:59pm the day before a booking is required. If you require a booking or an amendment for the same day, please contact the office. 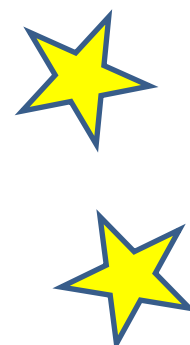
