This is the only way to give consent for your child to have the vaccine. Even if you do not want your child to have the vaccine, there is a NO form that you need to complete.

We are delighted to welcome back much-loved and ever popular children's author Dame Jacqueline Wilson to Simply Books!

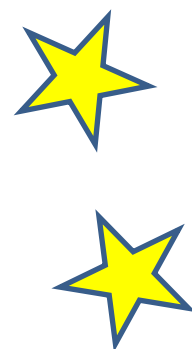

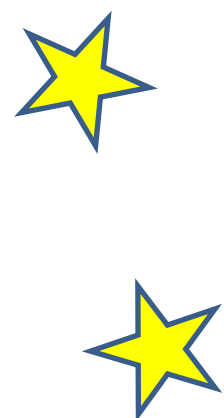

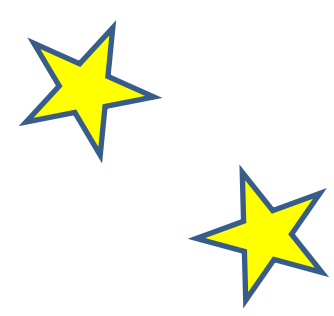
