Overview of Home Learning

We are strictly adhering to the procedures that we have in place, which is reducing risks, however in the event of a child not being able to attend school due to isolating we have formed a plan for home learning.

We started this term with the intention of using Class Dojo as the platform for setting work and giving feedback but we have found that some of the features are quite limited. Therefore, we have decided to use Seesaw as we did in the summer term for those year groups who did not return to school. We will continue to use Class Dojo for our reward system and communication with parents. Information about Seesaw and how to sign up, will be sent out next week by your child's class teacher.

If your child is isolating the following will apply:

- **When an absence is reported due to Covid-19 reasons, home learning will be set the following day on Seesaw**
- Reception: A daily phonics activity, a maths or literacy activity and one activity that comes under the seven areas of learning will be uploaded to your child's portfolio on Seesaw. Parents will also be encouraged to continue to use Tapestry
- KS1 & KS2: Daily tasks for English, phonics (KS1), maths, guided reading and a foundation subject will be uploaded to your child's portfolio on Seesaw
- These tasks will be based on the learning that they would have been doing if they were in the classroom
- Teachers will mark work that is uploaded to your child's portfolio. Please upload work as and when it is completed where possible but no later than 3.30pm
- Teachers will not be able to provide further work but children will have access to the ongoing homework learning resources such as Mathletics and Rising Stars online reading
- Please remember that your child's teacher will be in class teaching all day

If your child's bubble has closed the following will apply:

- **If you are informed that your child's bubble has closed, home learning will be set the following day on Seesaw**
- Teachers will upload a daily timetable that parents can choose to follow
- Reception: A daily phonics activity, a maths or literacy activity and one activity that comes under the seven areas of learning will be uploaded to your child's portfolio on Seesaw. Parents will also be encouraged to continue to use Tapestry
- KS1 & KS2: Daily tasks for English, phonics (KS1), maths, guided reading and a foundation subject will be uploaded to your child's portfolio on Seesaw
- These tasks will be based on the learning that they would have been doing if they were in the classroom
- Teachers may upload videos onto Seesaw, which will be explanations or modelling the activity / task
- Teachers where possible will timetable teaching sessions over the week for your child on Microsoft teams – these will be done in small groups and will last no longer than 30 minutes
- A separate information sheet on how we will operate with Microsoft Teams will be sent out
- Teachers will mark work that is uploaded to your child's portfolio. Reading, writing and maths work is to be submitted by 2pm to be guaranteed teacher response. We politely request that work is uploaded as it is completed rather than all pieces being added at 2pm. All curriculum tasks to be submitted by 3.30pm and teachers will comment by the end of the week.



- If your child's class teacher is ill during the bubble closure, tasks will still be uploaded and marked but unfortunately there will be no online sessions via Microsoft Teams

It is important to us that all our pupils receive quality teaching and learning opportunities and make excellent progress. It is vital that we are able to work in partnership with our families to continue to drive our creative curriculum and we appreciate your support, especially with this new way of working through these challenging times.
